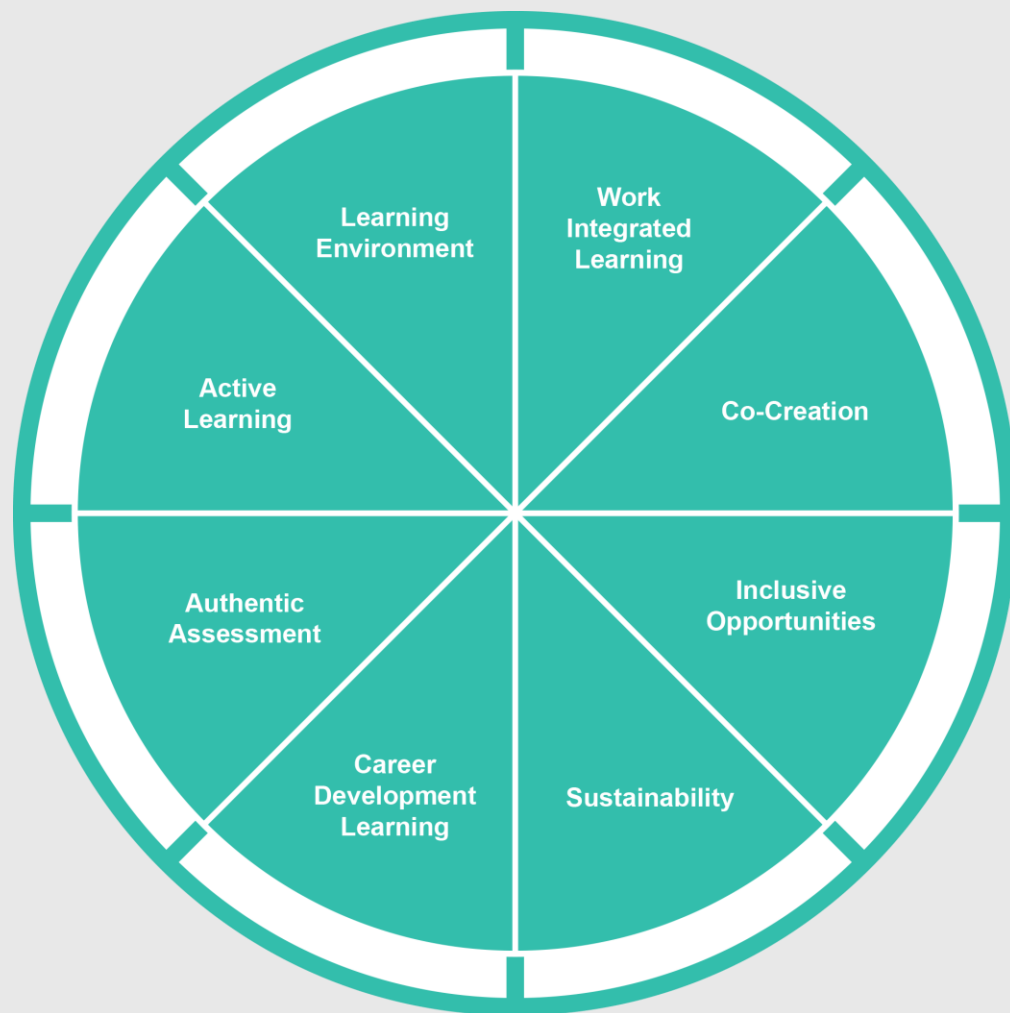






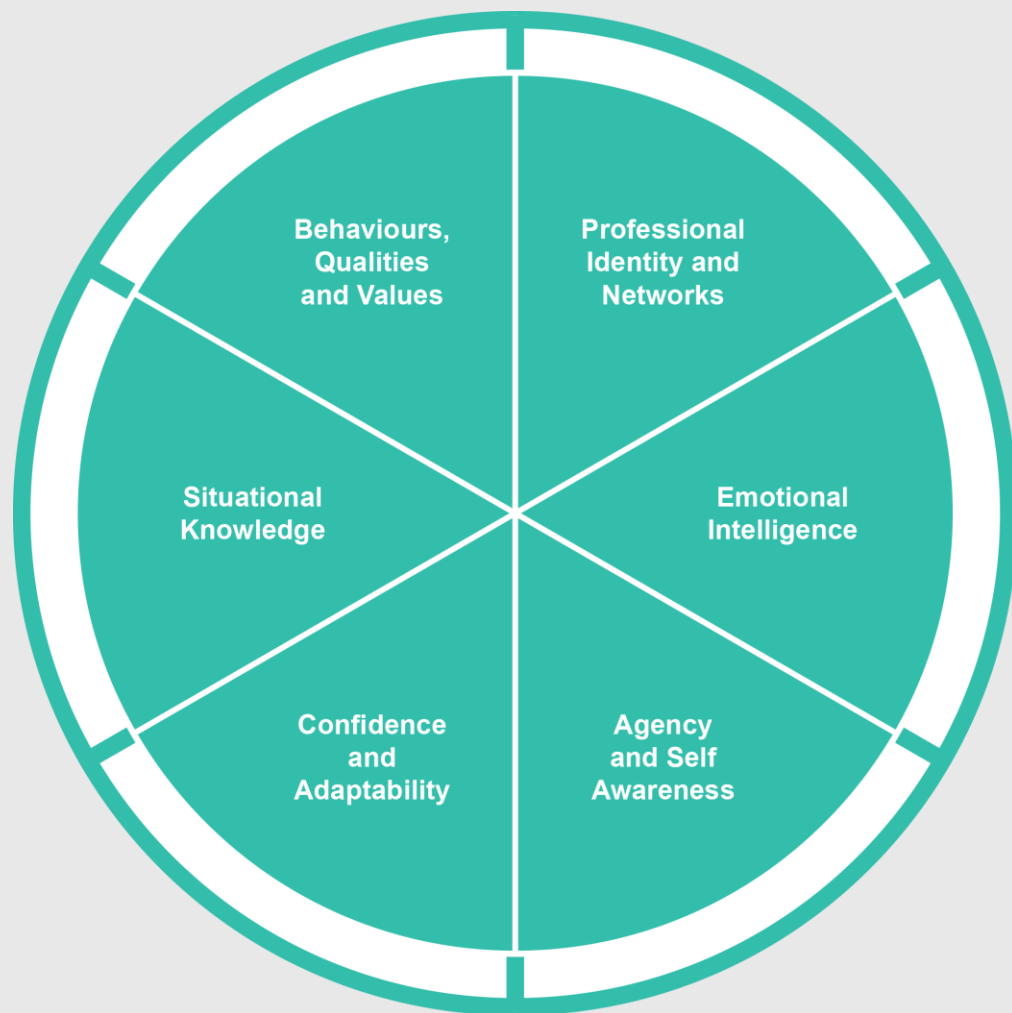
How the framework is structured - **Institution**

- + **Develop strategic priorities and enhance culture** through shared ownership of policies and processes.
- + Encourage a **shared vision and values**; providing creative and innovative practices.
- + Foster and develop the **relationship between institutions, and both external and internal stakeholders**.



How the framework is structured – **Educators+**

- + Acts as a **benchmark to map against** and/or consider current practice.
- + Develops **collaborative engagement** across professional services, within disciplinary teams and for multi and interdisciplinary activity.
- + Provides a resource that can **identify and recognise professional development**, needs and requirements.



How the framework is structured – **Students**

- + Offers a structure for **identifying key elements** that can positively impact on a learner's experience.
- + Identifies core components to help **develop a shared and common understanding** of employability.
- + Allows for **contextual understanding** and recognises that areas will be under varying degrees of focus through different learning experiences and stages.

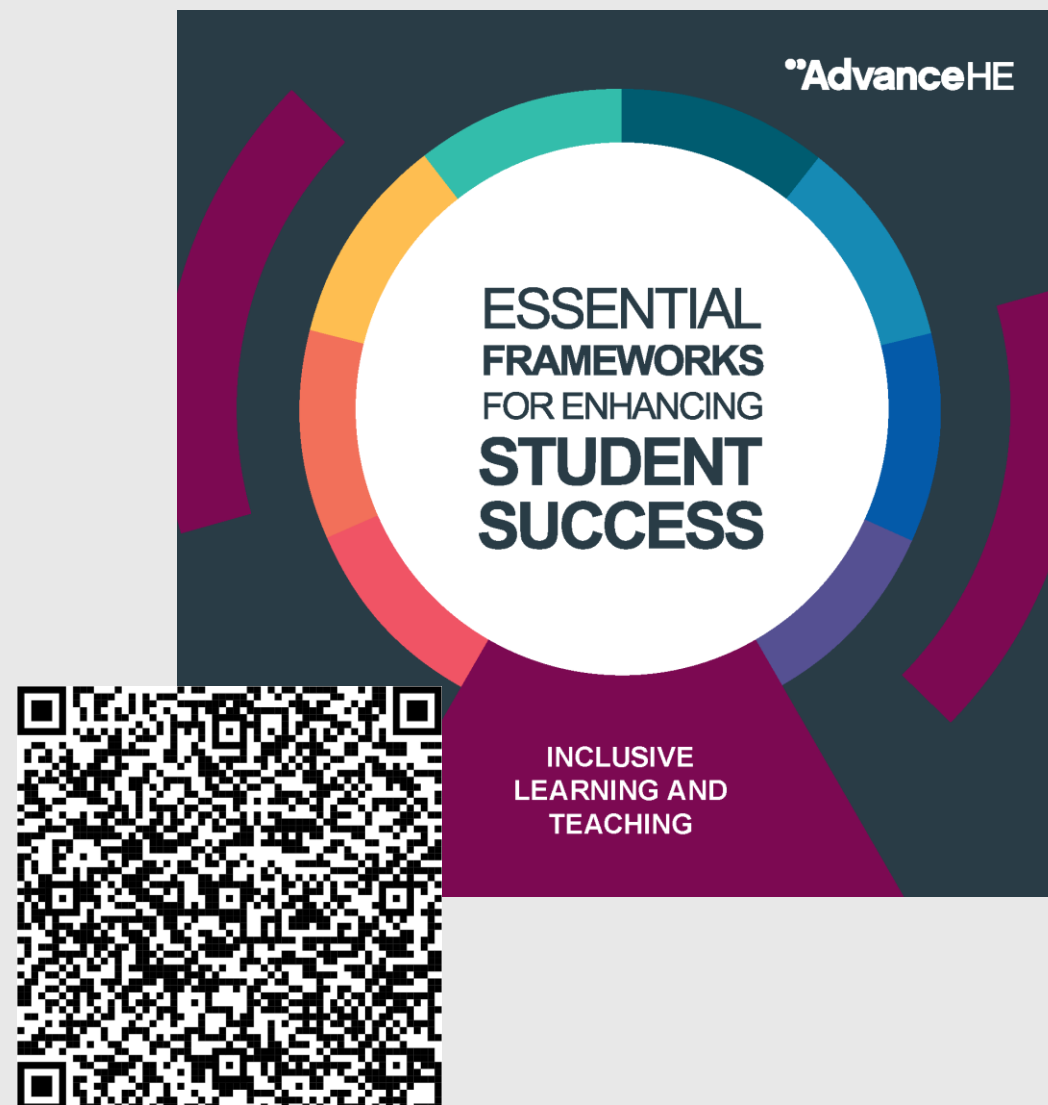
